## FROM DRUG ADDICT TO NEUROSCIENTIST

Substance abuse is a major public health crisis that effects everyone and the teen years pose some of the most difficult challenges. With more than one in every five people over the age of fourteen addicted, it is difficult to know which teens will merely try alcohol, marijuana, tobacco and other drugs and which teens may potentially develop a dependency.

Professor Judith Grisel is a renowned behavioral neuroscientist and recovered drug addict. Here is a clear understanding of the brain science of drug addiction. Why are specific drugs cocaine, heroin, methamphetamine, nicotine, alcohol, marijuana, and ecstasy so hard to kick? What are the experiential effects of each drug? Dr. Grisel's extensive brain research, journey to recovery and commitment to a more compassionate response to the epidemic in our homes and communities led to her book *Never* Enough: The Neuroscience and Experience of Addiction.
